All applicants must meet the validation and verification process using the 6-point system

NJ minimum age to apply is 14 years old

New Brunswick City ID is accepted Identification:

- To all City buildings
- To New Brunswick Public Schools
- For the New Brunswick Police Department
- To city sponsored events/services

NEW BRUNSWICK CITY ID Cardholders can receive:

Access to free library services including:

- Internet
- Various material to check out (books, DVDs, and magazines)
- Streaming services and more!

***All Library Cardholders Must Comply with Library Policies.**

New Brunswick City ID Benefits:

- A library card that grants the cardholder all borrowing privileges to the New Brunswick Free Public Library
- Cardholder will receive access to services provided by the City of New Brunswick

Is My Privacy Protected?

Yes! The New Brunswick ID Program will not retain copies of the documents you present to apply for the ID.

NEW BRUNSWIC CITY ID:

- Verifies that you are a resident of the City of New Brunswick
- Valid for a term of two (2) years from the date of issuance

Documentation Requirements to Apply for the NEW BRUNSWICK CITY ID

Requires at least 4 points to prove identity and 2 points to prove residency in New Brunswick

(Please note that this is only a ****partial**** list of accepted documents. For a complete list, pick up an application or visit www.nbfpl.org)

IDENTITY

Four (4) Points- Identity/Residency

- U.S. State Driver's License or Learner's Permit Photo ID
- U.S. State Identification Card

Three (3) Points- Identity

- Consular ID Card with photograph
- U.S. or Foreign Passport
- U.S. Military Identification Card
- State Veteran ID with photo

Two (2) Points- Identity

- Proof of a minor enrolled in New Brunswick Public or Private School
- Prisoner ID Card
- Birth Certificate (Foreign)

RESIDENCY IN NEW BRUNSWICK

Two (2) Points- Proof of Residency

- Utility bill with name and address
- Cable bill
- Notarized Residential Lease

One (1) Point- Proof of Residency

- Employment Pay Stub
- Bank Statement
- Income Tax filing form (1 year)

ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE ORIGINALS, CURRENT OR IF EXPIRED, SAID EXPIRATION MUST BE TWO (2) YEARS OR LESS FROM THE DATE OF PRESENTATION
